FIRST MINTING OF 5 CENT COINS WAS 1858

MONARCH CHANGE 1902 WITH BOTH LARGE AND SMALL H FOR HEATON MINT

1905 FIRST YEAR ROYAL CANADIAN MINT

MONARCH CHANGE TO GEORGE V 1911 TO 1921

MAY 1921 THE REQUIREMENT TO BE MADE IN SILVER REMOVED AND COINS IN INVENTORY MELTED DOWN

1922 WAS BEGINNING OF NICKLE CONTENT WITH NEW SIZE TO MATCH U.S. 5 CENT PIECES TO ENCOURAGE TRADE BETWEEN NATIONS.

1936 GEORGE VI ISSUES

SHORTAGE OF NICKLE DUE TO WAR EFFORT LEADS TO 1942 AND 1943 TOMBAC ISSUES. 12 SIDED TO PREVENT CONFUSION WITH PENNY

1944 ISSUE NOW CHROME PLATED STEEL COIN BECAUSE OF COPPER SHORTAGE IN WAR EFFORT

1946 NICKLE AGAIN. KEPT 12 SIDED DUE TO POPULARITY.

1948 EMPEROR OF INDIA REMOVED

1953 ELIZABETH II ISSUES

1963 NICKLES ROUND AGAIN

1965 PORTRAIT CHANGE

1965 CENTENNIAL ISSUE
